### 4. Feedback on Regional CYC Action Plan – Simone/Louise

- Feedback raised concerns of the lack of consultation in developing the plan – concern that the plan felt imposed on local CYCs
  - Simone and Louise explained that the exercise of developing the plan was to bring focus to the work of the Regional CYC and that the activity of bringing the drafted plan to the local CYCs was incorporated to seek feedback
- Feedback requested a regular exchange and update regarding the implementation of the regional plan.
  - Simone and Louise said they would propose that updates from the Regional CYC would be a standing item on the ACYC agenda.
