for seniors, those with a disability designation (PWD) and those under ICBC claims. Appointments must
be outside of Abbotsford. There is a fee for their service (49 cents/kilometer, plus parking) – all drivers
are volunteers.

To request medical transportation, it is encouraged that you phone for reservations five business days in advance.

- HandyDART is an accessible, door-to-door shared transit service for people with permanent or temporary disabilities that prevent them from using fixed-route transit without assistance from another person. HandyDART picks you up at your accessible door and drops you off at the accessible door of your destination.
- Taxi Saver Program: When HandyDART cannot accommodate a HandyPASS holders travel needs, they can use Taxi Saver vouchers for one-time trips. A limited quantity of Taxi Saver vouchers are available to permanently registered HandyDART riders only.
